CHESS

EXTENDED ART WITH MARTINE

Come and join the Monday Art Class, which will run from 3.05-4.30pm. Students will have fun learning about, and making lots of great art. This term children will paint, print, sculpt, glue and recycle to create artworks. May Ziade has worked closely with Martine who has taught Art at St Joseph's College, and is a wonderful inspiration to all her students. We do allow you to use your discretion regarding the new minimum age requirement, should you feel your child has the ability to concentrate for this long period of time after a full day of school, though Term 1 K students are discouraged.

KIDS YOGA

Tee's Kid's Yoga introduces children to the enormous benefits that can be derived from yoga improving flexibility, strength, coordination, body awareness, and concentration. These classes teach children to connect mind body and breath in a relaxed, non-competitive environment.

Our children thrive, however we forget how much these influences can affect our children's innate joy. Andrew's classes are designed to challenge our kids through games and activities in a fun play environment. These workshops are about keeping FIT through PLAY!

COOKING CLASSES

Calling all mini chefs! This cooking class will focus on creating (mostly) healthy homemade savory and sweet treats. We will discuss how to pick, prepare, and cook a range of cuisines. We will also discuss safe kitchen and knife skills, kitchen hygiene and food safety, as well as table setting and dining etiquette. After the class the mini chefs will get to take home the food they've made...if it lasts that long! Class includes recipe booklet to take home at the end of the term. The class is limited to 8 primary students, and children with a nut allergy will be catered for.

SKATEBOARDING WORKSHOPS FOR KIDS

Our Tuesday course will consist of, introduction to skateboarding, skateboarding safety induction, skateboarding fundamentals, skateboarding tips and tricks, skateboarding themed games, professional demonstrations, and time to practice skills learnt on the ramps. Adam skilfully manages children of all levels ensuring that everyone has fun.

HIP HOP DANCE

Mr Jad is a 26 year old Hip-hop Teacher, performer and dance choreographer with more than 15 years experience, and who is very excited to share his passion for dance with Hunters Hill Primary School children. He has choreographed 'The Immaculate Crew' and the '3D dancers' as well as performing with the 'Blackout Crew'. Mr Jad currently teaches Hip Hop at 'Rhapsody Studios' and 'The Dance hub' in Melrose Park.

Please ensure your child has an afternoon snack for the Hip Hop EXTRA classes as they run for 2 hours.

SPANISH CLASSES

In Spanish is a unique and fun way for kids to learn Spanish. We specialise in Spanish lessons for young kids, between the ages of 2.5 to 12. In order for the children to make the most of the lesson and to participate in all activities there will be two groups of maximum of 10 children divided in K to Year 2 and Years 3 to 6.

Every class is full of songs, movement, pretend play and games in Spanish. The children have a lot of fun, and they learn another language whilst doing things they love.

The program includes:

- Quality classes of 60 minutes each with a Spanish native speaker
- Support material (CD with dialogs and songs, a Dialogs, songs and pronunciation book and a Student's workbook)

TAEKWONDO

Taught by Greg Wyllie and Paul Clapham of Wyllie Taekwondo, the program offers comprehensive fitness, improved coordination and concentration, as well as a system of self-defence. Children will need loose pants or shorts – no footwear required. Children will have the opportunity to be graded with belts being awarded at an additional cost payable directly to Wyllie Taekwondo.

FENCING

The course is for children from the **age of 6 upwards** covers all aspects of the sport including safety points, grip, stance positions, attack and defensive moves. The foils used are made with soft ends ensuring a safe, enjoyable and tactical sport. All safety equipment and clothing will be provided but children should wear comfortable clothing INCLUDING SPORTS SHOES.

LEGO ENGINEERING

KUNG-FU CLASSES

Master Instructor Chongwei Zhang is a 7th Dan of Chinese Kung-Fu and a 6th Dan Black belt of Taekwondo. He has won China's national Tai Chi, Kung-Fu and Taekwondo championships more than 30 times. Master Zhang was a stunt coordinator and performer for Jackie Chan's Hollywood Movies in 2003/2004 and is also teaching in Eastwood and Hornsbury.

- All enrolments are to be made through the TryBooking website. Bookings are only accessible through the private link that will be sent out by the school, and will also be located on the HHPS Schoolbag Application
- Unless you hear from the Enrolment Officers to the contrary, your child has been accepted in to the class of his/her choice.

 The Enrolment Officer only contacts the parents of those children who have NOT been accepted, for whatever reason, into a particular class in order to ascertain whether a substitute class or refund is appropriate.
- · If a class is full, please complete the details for the waitlist and you will be notified via email if a place becomes available
- REFUNDS WILL NOT BE OFFERED NOR SUBSTITUTION OF CLASSES ALLOWED ONCE ENROLMENTS HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED. Please select classes carefully
- Refunds will not be given for classes missed or forgotten by the attendee
- Discounts will not be offered for part attendance
- In the event of any child continually disrupting a class with bad behaviour, the Committee reserves the right to ask parents to withdraw that child. In this event, there will not be a refund of fees.
- As an after school activity, neither the staff of Hunters Hill Primary School nor the Creative Workshop Committee members can be responsible for children before classes commence, or after their scheduled conclusion. All children who attend Creative Workshops and intend to use HHOOSH, must be registered with HOOSH and booked in. All children must be asked by their parents to wait for the instructors quietly and respectfully.
- Please be punctual collecting children after class, as teachers have to leave for other commitments and children would be left unsupervised.
- The Federation of P&C Association has insurance cover for classes run by the Creative Workshops Committee, however in the case of sports classes, any accident occurring in the normal course of the class is not covered by the P&C policy. Instructors carry their own Public Liability Insurance but parents are advised to take their own insurance precautions for their child, depending on the activity their child is undertaking.
- If there are insufficient enrolments for a class to operate, it will be cancelled, or separate classes may be combined to form one class.
- · No classes run on Public Holidays fees are adjusted accordingly in the brochure for any classes that are affected by such

- It is the parents' responsibility to confirm and remember that their child is enrolled in a particular class.
- In the event a class is cancelled because of a teacher's inability to attend (or public holiday, strike etc.), every effort will be made to offer an alternative session. If it is not possible to offer a make-up session, no refunds will be given.
- Please remember to make a note in your diaries of when classes commence and finish and make sure your children are aware of this. Any changes will be notified via the School Newsletter
- Each workshop booked through TryBooking will incur a 30c surcharge, however credit card fees are covered by the Creative Workshops Committee
- In the event of a cancelled class, a full refund will be given, with the exception of the 30c surcharge.
